Digital Fitness for Car Dealerships

At the Automotive Trend Forum (ATF) in Wolfsburg from May 8 to 9, 2019, DEKRA will be presenting concepts aimed at helping the SME-dominated sector to face the digital transformation. One initial concept is the Digital Readiness Check, which allows companies to review their digital fitness online for free.
