DEKRA sustainability program wins national award and receives international nomination

The DEKRA Climate Impact Program has received recognition on two fronts: It took first place in the “Corporate Strategy” category of the German Award for Sustainability Projects 2026. At the same time, DEKRA has been shortlisted for the Reuters Events Global Sustainability Awards 2026 in the “SDG Pioneer Award” category.

The German Award for Sustainability Projects is presented by ntv, DUP UNTERNEHMER and the German Institute for Service Quality (DISQ). It recognizes projects that advance sustainability with particular impact, innovation and relevance. Among a total of 433 submitted projects, the DEKRA Climate Impact Program impressed the jury with its holistic approach to corporate climate responsibility.

Additional international recognition for the DEKRA program

The program is also receiving recognition at international level: DEKRA has been shortlisted for the Reuters Events Global Sustainability Awards 2026. The “SDG Pioneer Award” category recognizes organizations whose initiatives make a significant contribution to achieving the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. The awards ceremony will take place in London on October 21, 2026.

The DEKRA Climate Impact Program combines science-based climate targets with concrete measures to reduce emissions and the financing of climate protection and climate adaptation projects. Its aim is to systematically reduce DEKRA's own climate impact while at the same time making a measurable contribution to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.
