

You wish to have your company certified as part of a multisite-oriented procedure. This is subject to compliance with the specific accreditation-related criteria listed below. In the event that individual criteria are not met then each operating facility / organizational unit must be certified individually.

The following criteria are applicable:

- a) The organization must have a headquarter through which the food safety management system activities are planned, controlled and managed according to the requirements of ISO 22000:2005 chapter 4.
- b) All relevant sites (including the central administration function) shall be subject to an internal audit plan of the organization and must have been audited in accordance with this plan prior to an audit by DEKRA Certification GmbH.
- c) Nonconformities of the sites must be considered as important for the whole system and corrective actions must be taken accordingly.
- d) The multi-site procedure is only applicable for categories A, B, E, F and G and for organizations with more than 20 sites, which have similar processes within a category.
- e) In organizations with up to 20 sites, every site must be audited. In organizations with more than 20 sites, a sample of 1 site has to be taken for every 5 more sites. All sites must be chosen by chance, none of the visited sites may have nonconformities after the audit.
