6. Recertification

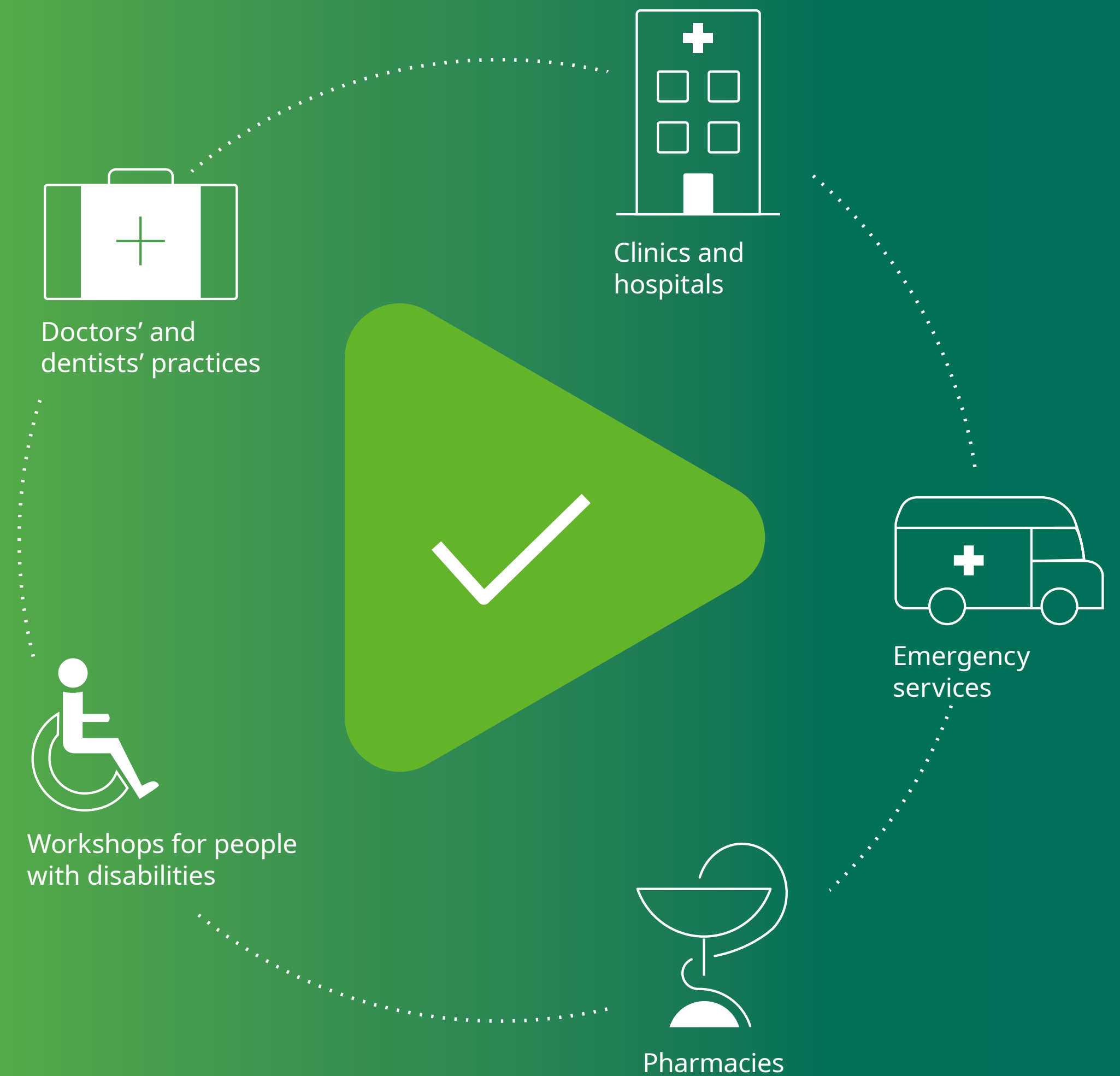
After successful certification according to MAAS-BGW, companies receive a refund on their premiums from the employer's liability insurance association. This is generally 50% of the certification costs, up to a maximum of 50% of the annual fee to the BGW, not including insolvency payments, advances or external charges.
