

UK Explosion Safety - What are the new requirements?



CE marking

- › Will be recognized in the market of Great Britain until 31 Dec 2024
- › No plans to allow CE stock to be sold off after this date
- › Will include new products (ie certified after Brexit and until 31 Dec 2024)
- › Easement includes spare parts / replacements for products on the market (ie a product placed on the market with CE marking can be repaired by parts with CE marking)



UKCA marking

- › Recognized now, but not required until 1 Jan 2025
- › Can be based on CE marking until 31 Dec 2027
- › Product specific requirements as to whether it can be placed on the product



Labelling

- › UKCA labelling criteria need to be followed for UKCA marking
- › For goods from the EEA, importer details can be affixed on to the product via a sticky label / accompanying documentation until 31 Dec 2027
- › Accompanying documents must meet end user
- › Dual marking is allowed for the UK, but labelling requirements are to be met
