EHS Compliance Assessment Establishing a Strong Foundation

- Identifies applicable regulatory requirements (OSHA, EPA, state/local)
- Reviews programs, permits, and documentation
- Conducts walk-throughs to observe operations and hazards
- Verifies training and employee awareness
- Evaluates equipment, controls, and safety systems
- Assesses chemical management, labeling, and storage
- Reviews waste handling and environmental controls
Documents findings with corrective actions and priorities

Holistic Assessment Expanding Performance and Maturity

- Evaluates the full safety system, including culture and leadership alignment
- Benchmarks performance against industry peers and across industries
- Identifies 3–5 high-impact improvement opportunities
- Focuses on culture as a foundation for long-term success
- Provides a clear, prioritized road map for implementation
- Aligns safety efforts with broader operational goals

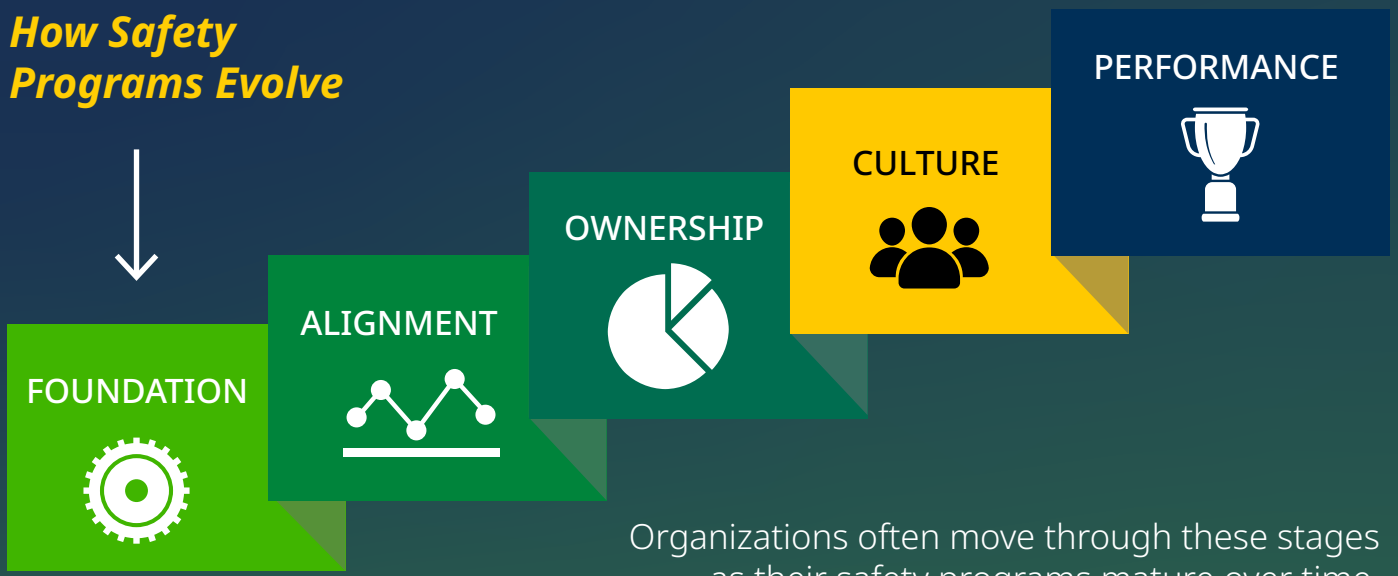
