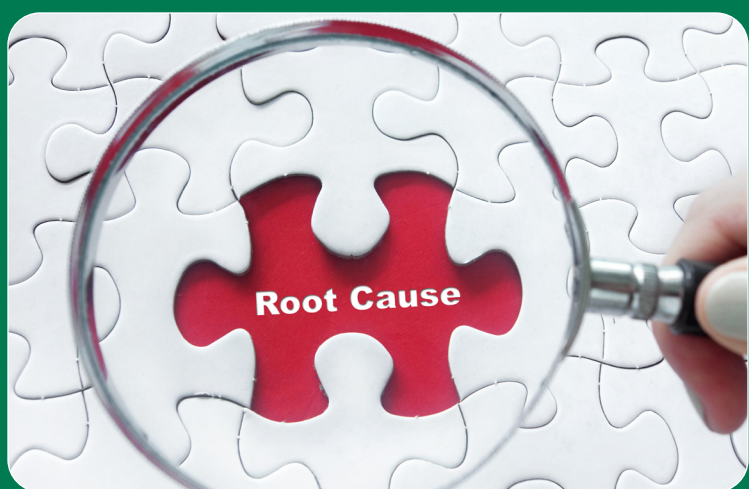


Five Ways to Prevent Catastrophic Incidents

Catastrophic Incidents usually occur after early warning signals are overlooked.



1 Anticipation

Recognize the early warning signs that help head off incidents.

2 Questioning

Protect team decisions from their natural biases, so they rely on data rather than intuition.



3 Diligence

Assure consistent and reliable use of safety programs and processes.



4 Resilience

Develop the agility to recognize and quickly respond to exposures in real time.



5 Learning

Make learning routine rather than waiting for an incident to trigger learning mode.
